**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
CALIFORNIA PINES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
MODOC, COUNTY, CALIFORNIA  
CONTINUE ASSESSMENTS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF GRAVEL ROADS  
AND PAVED STREETS IN CERTAIN AREAS FOR  
FISCAL YEAR 2021/22**

**WHERE AS**, the Benefit Assessment Act of 1982 of California Government Code Section 54710 et seq. Empowers the California Pines Community Service District to fix, levy and collect benefit assessments for the maintenance of streets within District boundaries; and

**IN ACCORDANCE** with Resolution # 93-1 approved and adopted on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 1993, the California Pines Community Services District Board of Directors hereby determine that the Benefit Assessment for the maintenance of gravel and paved streets should continue for the fiscal year **2021/22** at the rates set by Resolution #93-1.

**RESOLUTION 93-1** sets the rates as follows: Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00) per parcel per year for gravel streets and Twenty-One Dollars (\$21.00) per parcel per year for paved streets, collected on the tax role in the same manner as general taxes.
