GENERAL MANAGER’S REPORT: 11:20

- The General Manager reported that Nor-Cal EMS is sunsetting its Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) certification program effective February 10, 2026. California Pines Fire Department personnel will now need to obtain or renew EMR certification through the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT), or maintain Public Safety First Aid (PSFA) training as the minimum medical training standard required by California regulation. No further EMR certifications will be issued by Nor-Cal EMS, and current EMR holders must transition to NREMT or PSFA pathways.
 - The Board expressed its interest in providing firefighter training beyond the basic PSFA level and requested the General Manager to provide a cost breakdown for training personnel through the new certification pathways..
